The Lovett School senior student lounge incorporates colorful and bright design elements throughout the space to reflect and connect the vibrant student body's school activites. The furniture selected for this space is playful and easily movable in order to provide maximum flexibility within the space in order to accommodate various activities from casual gatherings and club meetings, to larger senior class presentations and activities. The entrance to this space was relocated and the stair from the café space bellow was redesigned, allowing for a safer flow of traffic during the morning rush.

The inclusion of a faculty office within the space allows the faculty observation of and easy access to the students for advisory activities. Interior windows along the corridor side wall allow for visibility into the student lounge, providing the opportunity for necessary adult supervision.

The floor to ceiling windows on the outside wall allow ample natural daylight into the space, creating a space that is welcoming for the students. Studies show that students perform better when provided with access to natural daylight. The new interior design ensures that the interior windows on the corridor wall also allow the daylight to continue into the adjacent corridor, thus maximizing the benefit of this existing design element for all students and faculty.
