The International Travelers' Club is an exclusive club located in the new International Terminal of the Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport. Travelers have a dramatic skyline view of downtown Atlanta through the 18' floor to ceiling windows along the north side of the space. The bar area immediately inside the general lounge has stools and televisions, which provides a relaxing and casual space as you enter the lounge. The entire space, including the bar, is ADA compliant for both guests and employees. Seating for 123 is accommodated by various configurations throughout the space; a large communal table with bar height stools allows large groups to eat together while smaller café style table tops for two can be easily moved to accommodate any size party. Individual seating is also provided through club lounge chairs, each with individual tables complete with table top power charging and a personal light fixture which creates a more intimate environment. Other special amenities include free wifi, two private full bathrooms complete with showers, and storage areas for fresh linens for all guests. There are two separate buffet areas; one for the general lounge and one for the first class lounge.

A curved feature wall separates the general lounge from the first class lounge and adds drama to the space. The venetian stucco and colored LED light fixtures offer a subtle elegance that is complimented nicely by the quartz countertops throughout the space. The carpet includes shades of grays and blacks, which creates a mood of quiet respite, and the muted texture and high recycled content meet the demands of the high traffic and have the ability to hide stains. The high-end finishes throughout the space are complimented by several classic mid-century designer accent pieces including Carl Hansen Shell Lounge Chairs in leather by Hans J Wegner and Amy Tobler tables. The International Travelers' Club Room provides International travelers with both comfort and functionality and serves as a respite from the hustle and bustle of the busiest airport in the world.
