

Richard Wittschiebe Hand purchased this 1930's vintage building formerly occupied as a nightclub. The building was to be renovated to house their architectural offices. The goal was to create a space that encouraged creativity and collaborative work within the office.

Renovation of the building had a profound effect on the rundown downtown neighborhood. The exterior is redefined with a new curved entry and openings allowing natural light throughout the entrance. The interior of the two-story brick building was reduced to its basic structure and simple forms inserted to define working spaces. The color palette is subdued resulting in a warm, inviting space.
